

Parent Engagement Partnership: Communication Structure

The Parent Engagement Partnership (PEP) is a mechanism to provide a way of consultation with parents across the City. It supports the Parenting Implementing Change Group and their development.

What makes the PEP successful is the 2 way communication between the PEP and local agencies. The communication structure is as follows:

The PEP will feed information to the Children's Centres via the Parent representative who will disseminate this information and feed back any issues, observations or comments to the PEP

Phase 1 Children's Centres will feed information into **Phase 2** Centres (that are currently in development) and the Parent Representative will feed their issues, observations or comments to the PEP along with Phase ones.

Locality Managers will feed directly to the PEP via the Family Support Officer who will disseminate the information from the PEP to them.

The PEP will feed information into the **Parent Groups** through the parents that sit on it. The groups issues, observations or comments will then be fed back to the PEP through these Parents

The information will be fed to the **Clusters** via the Cluster Managers and fed back to the PEP via the two way communication process.
